**Early Decision I - Requirements due by November 15, 2024**

**Early Decision II – Requirements due by January 15, 2025**

***For International students: If you wish to be considered for financial aid, you must submit a completed financial aid application at the time of applying for admission. You can request an updated financial aid review in subsequent years if significant changes to your family's finances have occurred. Please see below for application requirements. You do not have to apply for need-based financial aid to be considered for a merit scholarship.***

- Noncustodial Parent's Profile, if applicable** - If your parents are divorced, separated, or were never married and are living apart, your noncustodial parent is required to complete the Noncustodial Parent CSS Profile online if you are applying for need-based institutional grant aid. College Board will provide the student with more information regarding the process to send notification of the Noncustodial CSS Profile to their noncustodial parent after the Custodial CSS Profile has been completed.
  
- Verification of Parent Income** – Most recent custodial parent tax return or updated letter from employer (translated to English). *Upload this document on your application portal under the Financial Aid tab using the link.*
  
- Verification of Noncustodial Parent Income, if applicable** – Most recent noncustodial parent tax return or updated statement from employer (translated to English). *Upload this document on your application portal under the Financial Aid tab using the link.*
  
- Non-Tax Filer Statement, if applicable** – if you did not file a tax return or have a statement from employer, please submit a Non-Tax Filer Statement(s). *Upload this document on your application portal under the Financial Aid tab using the link.*
